

Jingle Jangle Jungle

TITLE: "Christmas Percussion Ensemble" Intermediate level

KEY CONCEPT(s): Rhythm, Ensemble, Timbre

OBJECTIVE: To review rhythms (5,6) and have students play in a percussion ensemble

DEVELOPMENT:

staff one is refrain of "Jingle Bells"

staff two is "merry merry christmas to you"

staff three is "Joy to the world the Lord is come"

staff four is "Go tell it on the mountain"

Speak Ostinati together bring in one at a time (2,3,4,1)

Transfer to percussion instruments and intro the same way

Add Shekere on 8th notes

EVALUATION: Have students speak rhythms and perform as an ensemble
